#### **CARING CONVERSATIONS**



Discuss in your home, small group, or use for personal reflections:

- In what ways can Taking Faith Home be used as a faith formation resource for yourself and your faith community?
- Do you send *Taking Faith Home* to college students, the home bound, or others to keep them connected to your congregation? Why or why not? Explain.

#### **DEVOTIONS**



Read: 1 Timothy 4:6-16.

We are not born with faith embedded within our chromosome structure. Faith does not appear on its own as we get older. In this reading, we are to "command and teach these things" (v. 11). Faith has to be taught and learned in life from others. Faith is formed by the power of the Holy Spirit through personal, trusted relationships, often in our own home. People need to be immersed into a faith-filled environment in the home to become fluent in a faith language. Fluency in a language cannot happen with only a one or two hour a week exposure within a congregational faith community. There has to be greater and more consistent immersion into a faith-filled nurturing environment for the Christian faith to become a way of life.

*Discuss:* Who taught you to grow in the Christian faith? How can you be a role model and teach others to devote themselves to God's word?

*Pray:* Loving God, thank you for allowing us to teach and share our faith with others as we grow in grace through Christ our Lord. Amen.

## **RITUALS AND TRADITIONS**



Taking Faith Home is based on the Revised Common Lectionary. It includes one for each Sunday plus ones for other times such as holidays. Each one includes talking about weekly mountain highs and valley lows before the Four Key Faith Practices of Caring Conversations, Devotions, Service, and Rituals and Traditions. Each week also includes prayers, Bible readings, a blessing, and suggested hymns. The Taking Faith Home User Guide can be printed, sent in an email, or posted on a website for each person to assist them on how to best utilize this faith formation resource in their daily lives.
