"The Parish Petunia"

In this season of blooming flowers, I'm reminded of a wise, retired pastor from a former congregation who taught me that church members are like flowers.

He said, "Like flowers, church members come in many different varieties, each with their own special needs. Some members are like roses. You have to be careful around them in order to avoid pain. Other church members are like azaleas. They bloom beautifully, but only if conditions are just the way they like it. Some parishioners," he said, "are like irises, and have the need to constantly be in the light. Violets, on the other hand, have so much to offer the church, but shyly shrink away to the shadows. And still other church members are like morning-glories. They bloom at the beginning of the day, but fade by noon."

"There are many different kinds of flowers in the church," he told me, "and they're all beautiful and helpful in their own way, but the members you'll appreciate the most are the petunias. Everybody overlooks petunias, but they just keep blooming, anyway. Petunias don't require a lot of care and nurturing. They don't demand attention, nor are they bothered by it. Petunias contribute their efforts without expecting a blue ribbon. They aren't picky about conditions being just the way they want them, nor do they cause trouble by trying to take over another flower's area. Petunias just keep quietly blooming and doing the best they can where they are."

"So, my friend," the pastor said to me, "when you've had a hard day trying to work with and take care of all of those different flowers in your church garden, don't forget to thank God for the petunias!"

I do give thanks to God for all of you, dear flowers, and I am blessed to be at a congregation with so many petunias!

Bell Restoration and Stain Glass repair

Wow! St. John, what a great Kick Start! We have \$2177 from the first 3 weeks of July. That went over the original \$2000 goal. Buildings and Grounds have indicated that they have a plan, beginning with moving that bell out of storage and getting a start on the restoration. I

will try to update you more next week on that. Many thanks to our generous donors and to Building and Grounds for their hard work.

The second phase of our 100-year anniversary project is to repair the stain glass window on the Gilbert St. side of the church. Basically, it needs repair around the framing. We do not have an estimate yet, but very likely all of the next \$3000 goal that we set will be needed. It is not a budgeted item. I think that after 100 years in this church building it makes sense that we should take care of the brick and mortar as well as our congregational needs. 100 years ago, Rev. Caselmann left his estate to this congregation to build this church, because of his love for it. Now it is up to us to carry on and maintain it for the future.


